TANGEDCO – COVID-19 – Constitution of “TANGEDCO Pensioners’ Covid Non-Critical Care Financial Assistance Scheme” – Reimbursement of the Room charges and Pharmacy charges for Covid Non-critical care in empanelled hospitals – Orders – Issued.

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**PROCEEDINGS:**

Based on the orders issued by the Government in G.O. first read above, orders have been issued, implementing the New Health Insurance Scheme, 2018 for Pensioners (including spouse)/Family Pensioners of TANGEDCO through M/s.United India Insurance Company Limited with effect from 01.11.2018 – vide Proceedings second read above.

**2.** In the Government Order third read above, due to the present pandemic caused by COVID-19, the Health and Family Welfare Department had issued an order for covering treatment of COVID-19 under Chief Minister Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme (CMCHIS). It was also stated therein that the Finance Department was to fix the ceiling for treatment charges for COVID-19 positive cases, for New Health Insurance Scheme for Employees and Pensioners. Accordingly, the Finance Department/Government of Tamil Nadu have issued orders including new Packages for treatment of Critical and Non-Critical care for COVID-19 positive cases covered under New Health Insurance Scheme for the Government Employees and Pensioners – vide Government Orders fourth and fifth read above. As per the said orders, the Pensioners/Family Pensioners/Exgratia beneficiaries of TANGEDCO who are enrolled under the existing New Health Insurance Scheme 2018, may avail the Cashless treatment for Critical care for COVID-19. However, they cannot avail the Cashless treatment for Non-Critical care for COVID-19 under the said Scheme. Hence, the feasibility of extending a similar benefit to the Pensioners of TANGEDCO as is being allowed to the Government Pensioners, has been examined in detail. After thorough examination, it has been decided to form a new scheme, viz. **“TANGEDCO Pensioners’ Covid Non-Critical Care Financial Assistance Scheme”**, for

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reimbursement of the Room Charges and Pharmacy charges incurred by the Pensioners (including spouse)/Family Pensioners of TANGEDCO for having taken Non-Critical Covid Care treatments in empanelled hospitals, as per the rates prescribed in the Government Orders fourth and fifth read above. Accordingly, the following orders are issued:

- (i) (a) A separate Fund called "**TANGEDCO Pensioners' Covid Non-Critical Care Financial Assistance Fund**" with an initial Corpus of Rs.1.18 Crores (Rupees one crore and eighteen lakhs only), be constituted to provide financial assistance to the pensioners, family pensioners and ex-gratia beneficiaries of TANGEDCO **for undergoing non-Critical Covid Care treatment at the empanelled hospitals**. The aforementioned Corpus will be recouped as and when required.
- (b) The said scheme shall be administered by the Chief Financial Controller/ General.
- (c) TANGEDCO's contribution shall be accounted in "75.164 - Contribution to TANGEDCO Pensioners' Covid Non-Critical Care Financial Assistance Fund".
- (d) Sanction of financial assistance to the Pensioners/Family Pensioners/ Exgratia beneficiaries shall be debited under the new head of account, viz."57.164 - TANGEDCO Pensioners' Covid Non-Critical Care Financial Assistance Fund".

(ii) With respect to **Critical care (ICU Ventilated & ICU Non-Ventilated)**,

- (a) The **United India Insurance Company limited** shall make payments to all **COVID** positive cases that receive critical care as per the package rates for existing procedures covered under the New Health Insurance Scheme, **subject to a ceiling of Rs.4 lakhs**.
- (b) In addition to the existing package rates, COVID-19 Management charges as prescribed for the Chief Minister Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme (CMCHIS) in G.O.Ms.No.240, Health and Family Welfare (EAPI-I) Department, dated 05.06.2020 shall be provided by United India Insurance Company Limited as follows:-

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- (iii) With respect to **Non-Critical COVID care**, the **TANGEDCO** fixes the following as the ceiling for treatment cost of **Non-Critical COVID** cases (cases confirmed based on RTPCR Test Report) **in empanelled hospitals** based on the Government rates for reimbursement under TANGEDCO Pensioners' Covid Non-Critical Care Financial Assistance Scheme:

1. A1 and A2 Category Hospitals (for individual room)	Rs.9,500/- per day + Pharmacy charges
2. A3-A6 Category Hospitals (for individual Room)	Rs.7,500/- per day + Pharmacy charges

(iv) **Payments to empanelled Hospitals:**

- (a) For critical care, M/s.United India Insurance Company Limited shall make payments to empanelled hospitals as per the recommended rates in para **2(ii)** above from the New Health Insurance Scheme account.
- (b) For non-critical care, the Room Charges and Pharmacy charges incurred by the Pensioners (including spouse) / Family Pensioners / Exgratia beneficiaries of TANGEDCO, for having taken **Non-Critical Covid Care treatments in empanelled hospitals**, shall be reimbursed under "TANGEDCO Pensioners' Covid Non-Critical Care Financial Assistance Scheme" at the rates specified in para **2(iii)** above.
- (v) **Payments to non-empanelled Hospitals:** M/s.United India Insurance Company Limited shall make payments as per the above rates as per para 2(ii) for critical care for COVID positive cases even in non-empanelled hospitals, as these treatments will come under the Emergency clause of New Health Insurance Scheme, after getting orders from the District Level Empowered Committee on appeal cases. **With respect to non-critical care**, TANGEDCO pensioners shall restrict their treatments to empanelled hospitals for the benefit of patient welfare.
- (vi) In respect of Critical Care, the empanelled hospitals should not collect any amount in excess other than the amount as prescribed by the Government and as mentioned in para 2(ii) above. M/s.United India Insurance Company Limited shall issue instructions to all the empanelled hospitals in this regard.
- (vii) The Pensioners (including spouse) / Family Pensioners / Ex-gratia beneficiaries, **who have taken treatment for Non-critical COVID care in empanelled Hospitals from 01.03.2020** are directed to submit their claims for reimbursement under the "TANGEDCO Pensioners' Covid Non-Critical Care Financial Assistance Scheme" to **the Deputy Secretary/ Miscellaneous, Secretariat Branch/TANGEDCO, IX Floor, NPKRR Maaligai, 144, Anna Salai, Chennai-600 002**, as per the **Check list Annexed** to this order.
- (viii) On receipt of the Sanction Order from the Secretariat Branch granting financial assistance to the Pensioners / Family Pensioners / Exgratia beneficiaries, the Chief Internal Audit Officer / Audit Branch shall make

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payment to the respective individual's Bank account from the "TANGEDCO Pensioners' Covid Non-Critical Care Financial Assistance Fund".

(ix) The Chief Internal Audit Officer/Audit Branch shall furnish a statement on the utilization of the Corpus Fund to the Secretary/TANGEDCO every month.
